Her "leisurely pace" is anything but for me. Whenever I come out of the water after a lake swim, or arrive at a convenience store for a rest break during our cycle trips, Tammy is always there—first—handing me a drink and sharing her energy bar.

Try as I might to stay with her, I am forever looking up to see her zooming along half a mile ahead, or flying over the top of a hill on her souped-up triathlon bike.

"I don't like to be behind anyone," she says matter of factly. "That's just how I am. I like speed."

She also likes to swim

double what everyone else swims during training. Running eight miles is a walk in the park for her, and she's just getting warmed up after 30 miles on her bike.

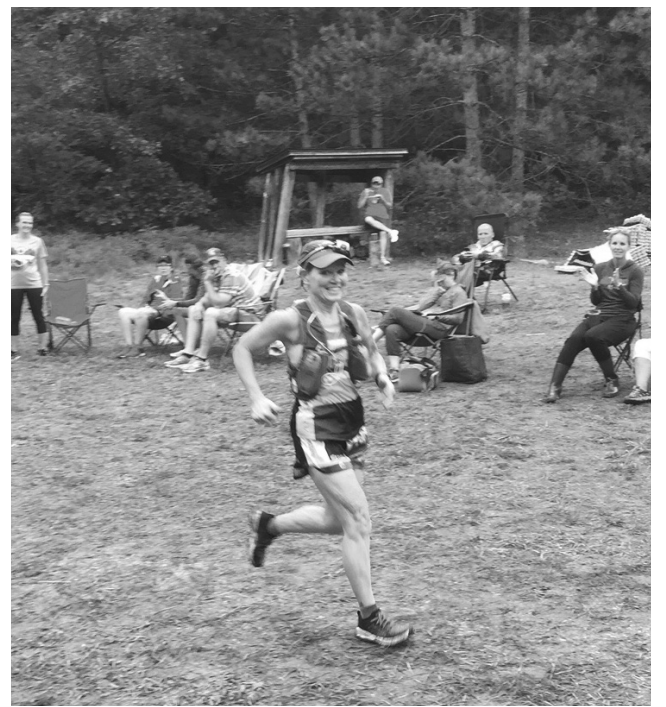
So, I was encouraged during my first triathlon at Diamond Lake when, on the last leg—the 3.3 mile run—I rounded the bend at the midway point and was headed to the finish line when Tammy passed me going the opposite direction. "Great job, Bill" she said cruising past in the other direction. What!? Wait a minute. That means Tammy is actually behind me.

I picked up my pace determined not to let her catch up with me. In fact, I wound up going head to head with another man the last 100 yards and poured it on with a dash to win my age group and finish a respectable 52 overall.



Later, at the finish line, Tammy and I studied the timing board for results. She casually chomped away on an apple—calm and cool. Being a seasoned triathlete, clearly she had participated in many post-race festivities. I, on the other hand, was exuberant. Rather smitten with myself, I turned to her and said, "So, how much did I edge you by?" Without hesitation—and with her characteristic frankness—she replied: "Oh, well, it's the other way around, Bill. I beat you by two minutes."

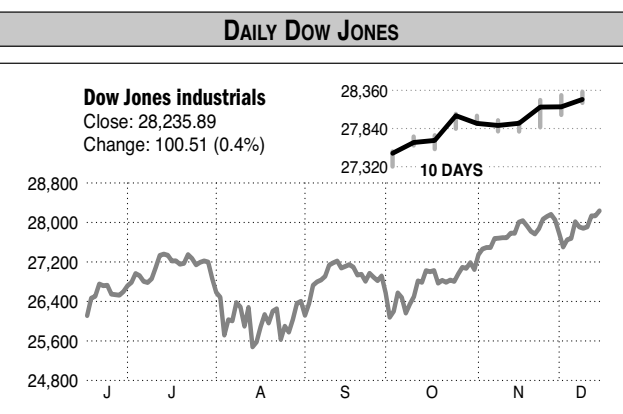
